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HOW THE CEE CITIZENS VIEW CHINA'S DEVELOPMENT

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
1. Background and key findings

China's trade relations play an increasing role in the Central and Eastern European countries. Citizens of the region's countries are also aware of this fact, but until now there were no available research that reflects the public's views on economic and trade development of the Central and Eastern European countries in connection with China. To bridge over this gap, the China-CEE Institute Nonprofit Ltd. had announced a tender. GKI won the tender and had prepared a study based on household surveys conducted in 16 countries in the CEE region. Dr He Zhigao and Mr. Ma Junchi from the China-CEE Institute, as well as Dr. Li Danlin from the Institute of Russian, East European and Central Asian Studies (CASS), had involved into the translation work from English to Chinese.

Fifty-nine percent of adult population in the CEE countries evaluates China's economic development in the last 2 years fast (thirty-one very fast), while only six percent considers it slow. Using the EU conjuncture research method, we transferred the answers 1 up to 5 into a -100-+100 scale, the average value is +41, which indicates a fast development for China in the eyes of the inhabitants of the CEE region. By countries the respondents of Slovenia, Romania, Serbia and Bulgaria consider China's economic development outstanding the fastest (from +57 to +61 points), while inhabitants of Bosnia-Herzegovina and Macedonia the lowest (+27 point).

How do you evaluate China's economic development in the last 2 years?





According to sixty-one percent of adult population of the surveyed region, China's importance in the world over the last 5 years has been improving (according to thirty-two percent, it improved a lot), while only 4 percent considers it has been deteriorating. On the -100-+100 scale, the average value is +43, which indicates a very significant improvement. The inhabitants of Slovenia consider China's importance the most improving (+63), while inhabitants of Bosnia-Herzegovina the less but still improving (+24).

How has China's importance in the world changed over the last 5 years?



Fifty-five percent of the adult CEE population has already heard about the cooperation between China and the Central and Eastern European countries, while forty-five percent hasn't. Nevertheless, exactly the half of those who have already heard about the cooperation, doesn't know what it is about, forty-four percent knows some, four percent is aware with a lot of details, while two percent indicated that this is completely clear for them. The countries where the most informed population lives are Poland, Serbia and Albania, at the same time the Romanian population is also informed but less in details. At the other end of the list are the less informed population countries, such as Estonia, Lithuania and Bulgaria.

Have you ever heard about the cooperation between China and the Central and Eastern European countries (16+1), in which your country participates? (distribution of answers %)





People in the CEE region believe that the **relationship between China and the CEE countries is rather close** (twenty-six percent of total) **than loose** (twenty-four percent of total), while half of the respondents is neutral in

this question. Serbia appears to be the country with the strongest relationship, Montenegro is considered to be second, Hungary is the third closest, while the Baltic states indicated the loosest connection.

1-very loose; 5-very close (distribution of answers %)



Thirty-four percent of the CEE adult population considers the possible impact of the new Silk Road (Belt and Road) Initiative (which aims to strengthen trade and economic relations between China and CEE countries) in the next 5 years fruitful (fourteen percent considers it is very fruitful). On the other hand, ten percent calculates with moderate impact, while only five percent thinks that this Initiative will have no impact at all. The inhabitants of Serbia consider the possible impact of the Initiative in the next 5 years the most fruitful (+31 point), followed by Lithuania (+30 point) and Romania (+26 point), while inhabitants of Estonia, Croatia and Bosnia-Herzegovina consider it the less. The average value is +13, which means a more positive than average consideration for the whole surveyed region.


How do you consider the possible impact of the new Silk Road Initiative in the next 5 years, which aims to strengthen trade and economic relations between China and your country?

2. Survey method

We have conducted primary research, a large-scale survey in the following countries:

- Poland
- Hungary
- Bulgaria
- Croatia
- Serbia
- Albania
- Macedonia
- Montenegro
- Bosnia-Herzegovina
- Slovakia

- Romania
- Czech Republic
- Slovenia
- Latvia
- Estonia
- Lithuania

Due to economic considerations, we have made the survey with three different partners: lpsos, GFK and TNS Kantor. The sample size (1000) was the same in every country, it totalled to 16,000 for the whole CEE region. The survey sample was representative by age, sex and education. Due to the strict deadline, the characteristic of the population in the different countries and the survey possibilities of the partner companies we used 3 different survey methods:

- CAPI (face-to-face interview) in 12 countries
- CAWI (on-line) in 3 countries
- CATI (by telephone) in 1 country

We asked the households 5 closed question, most measured on Likert-scale (1-5). These were the followings:

Q1. How do you evaluate China's economic development in the last 2 years?

1-very slow; 5-very fast

Q2. How has China's importance in the world changed over the last 5 years?

1-deteriorated a lot; 5-improved a lot

Q3. How strong do you think the relationship between China and your country?

1-very loose; 5-very close

- Q4. Have you ever heard about the cooperation between China and the Central and Eastern European countries (16+1), in which your country participates?
 - 1-no I haven't heard about it yet
 - 2-I have already heard about it, but I don't know what it is about
 - 3-I have already heard about it, and I know some details
 - 4-I have already heard about it, and I know a lot of details
 - 5-this is completely clear to me
- Q5. How do you consider the possible impact of the new Silk Road Initiative (Belt & Road Initiative) in the next 5 years, which aims to strengthen trade and economic relations between China and your country?

3. Evaluating China's economic development in the last 2 years

Almost two-third (59%) of adult people in the CEE countries evaluate China's economic development in the last 2 years fast (31% very fast), while only 6% considers it is to be slow (2% very slow). The remaining 36% is neutral in this question. The proportion of the very fast opinion is the highest in the countries:


- Bulgaria 47%,
- Serbia 47%,
- Slovenia 44%,
- and Romania 43%,

while the lowest in:

- Hungary 20%,
- Czech Republic 21%,
- Lithuania 24%,
- and Bosnia-Herzegovina 24%.

1-very slow; 5-very fast (distribution of answers %)



Following the EU conjuncture research method, the 1 to 5 scale was transferred to a -100 to +100 scale to eliminate neutral answers and to better show smaller differences between countries. Following this method, the inhabitants of Slovenia, Romania, Serbia and Bulgaria (between +57 and +61 points) consider China's economic development outstanding the fastest, while inhabitants of Bosnia-Herzegovina and Macedonia (+27 point) consider it the lowest (the other countries are between +33 and +42 point). The average value is +41, which indicates a very fast development for the whole surveyed region.

How do you evaluate China's economic development in the last 2 years?





By NUTS2 regions, inhabitants of the TOP3 region, which consider China's economic development the fastest, are Sud-Muntenia (+67) from Romania, Ruse (+66) and Varna (+63) from Bulgaria, while the lowest are four Bosnian regions: Herzegovina (-15), Posavski, Bosansko, Brcko merged small kantons (+11), Unsko-sanski kanton (+13) and Zenicko-dobojski kanton (+13).

4. Changes in China's importance in the world over the last 5 years


Similar to the previous question, a substantial proportion (61%) of people in the CEE countries evaluate China's importance in the world over the last 5 years has been improving (according to 32%, it improved a lot), while only 4% considers it has been deteriorating (by 1% it deteriorated a lot). The remaining 35% is neutral in this question. The share of "improved a lot" is the highest in the countries:


- Serbia 48%,
- Slovenia 45%,
- and Romania 43%,

while the lowest in:

- Czech Republic 19%,
- Hungary 22%,
- Poland 22%,
- and Bosnia-Herzegovina 22%.

How has China's importance in the world changed over the last 5 years?





If the results are transferred to the -100 to +100 scale, the inhabitants of Slovenia consider China's importance the most improving (+63), while inhabitants of Bosnia-Herzegovina the less, but still not deteriorating (+24). The other countries are between +34 and +59. The average value is +43, which indicates a very significant improvement in China's importance in the world.



By NUTS2 regions, inhabitants of the TOP3 region, which consider China's importance in the world the most improving are Vzhodna Slovenija (+64) from Slovenia, Sud-Est (+63) from Romania and Blagoevgrad (+63) from Bulgaria, while the lowest regions are four Bosnian regions, which are Herzegovina (-2), Zenicko-Dobojski kanton (0) and Posavski, Bosansko, Brcko merged small kantons (+4), which consider China's importance rather neutral, than improving.



5. The awareness of cooperation between China and the CEE countries

55% of the CEE people has already heard about the cooperation between China and the Central and Eastern European countries, while 45% hasn't. Exactly the half of those who has already heard about the cooperation, doesn't know what it is about, 44% knows some details, and only 4% knows a lot of details, while 2% indicated that this is completely clear for them.

The countries with the most detailed information about the cooperation are Poland, Serbia and Albania, at the same time the Romanian population is also informed but less in details. At the other end of the list are the less informed countries such as Estonia, Lithuania and Bulgaria. It's interesting that the Bulgarian people are not as well informed about the cooperation between China and their country as the CEE region average, in the light of their awareness about the Chinese development (measured two questions above).

Have you ever heard about the cooperation between China and the Central and Eastern European countries (16+1), in which your country participates? (distribution of answers %)





6. The strength of relationship between China and the CEE countries

People in the surveyed region believe that the relationship between China and the CEE countries is rather close (26% of total indicated) than loose (24% of total indicated), while half of the respondents is neutral in this question. Serbia appears to be the country with the strongest relationship, 40% indicated very close, while further 28% close connection.

How strong do you think the relationship between China and your country?






By NUTS2 regions, the inhabitants of the following **four Serbian regions**:

- Ssumadija / Zapadna (very close with +57 on the scale of -100-+100)
- Vojvodina (very close with +54)
- Juzna / Istocna (very close with +53)
- Beograd (close with +44)

perceive the strongest connection with China. In addition to the above two Bosnian, three Montenegrin and one Hungarian region is amongst the TOP10 region (value between +23 and +40). In the other end of the regional list, there are 17 Baltic, 2 Croatian and 1 Macedonian regions, which indicated rather loose than close connection (between -17 and -32 on the scale of -100-+100).

7. The evaluation of the possible impact of the new Silk Road (Belt and Road) Initiative

More than one-third (34%) of people in the CEE countries consider the possible impact of the new Silk Road Initiative (which aims to strengthen trade and economic relations between China and CEE countries) in the next 5 years fruitful (14% considers it very fruitful). On the other hand, 10% calculates with moderate impact, while only 5% thinks that this Initiative will have no impact at all. The remaining 51% is neutral in this question. The proportion of those, who considers a very fruitful impact, is the highest in the following countries:


- Lithuania (despite the loose relationship, they are confident in the possible impact of the new Silk Road Initiative),

How do you consider the possible impact of the new Silk Road Initiative in the next 5 years, which aims to strengthen trade and economic relations between China and your country?






How do you consider the possible impact of the new Silk Road Initiative in the next 5 years, which aims to strengthen trade and economic relations between China and your country?











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
































































